

As per the decision of Executive Committee meeting on 2nd April 2015 at INMAS, Delhi, following changes have been made in award of Life Membership to Non-Nuclear Medicine Professional and Nuclear Medicine Students and to Researchers in Nuclear Medicine.

Primary Membership: Nuclear Medicine Physician, Radiochemist, Radiopharmacist, Nuclear Medicine Physicist/Technologist possessing recognized Nuclear Medicine qualification. Persons without requisite recognized nuclear medicine qualifications but working in DAE/DRDO/BRIT/BARC in nuclear medicine related sections with post graduate degree in science and a minimum of five years experience could be considered for Primary Membership, but it needs to be verified by the head of the department where such applicants worked.

Associate Membership: Radiologists, Radiation Oncologists, Medical Biophysicists and Medical Specialists could be Associate Member. Associate Membership will be renewed every year. The Associate Membership fee was decided as 2500/- INR and the same amount would have to be paid every year at the time of renewal. Provisional Life Members would not have voting rights for election matters. However will be allowed to take all the benefit's of attending society's conferences as a member of SNMI and also a Student member.

Nuclear Medicine Students: For students undergoing professional training in Nuclear Medicine (Nuclear Medicine Physicians, Nuclear Medicine Physicists, and Nuclear Medicine Technologist) by a Degree or Diploma programme, a provisional Membership letter would be issued after charging the full membership fee which will be non-returnable. Final membership would be granted to them after they submit the copy of their degree. Provisional Life Members would not have voting rights for election matters. However will be allowed to take all the benefit's of attending society's conferences as a member of SNMI and also a Student member.

Nuclear Medicine Research Workers: For Research Workers in Nuclear Medicine with less than five years of Nuclear Medicine Research experience, a Provisional Membership letter would be issued after charging the full membership fee which will be non-returnable. Final membership would be granted to them after they submit proof of their eligibility to be awarded Primary Membership as above. Provisional Life Members would not have voting rights for election matters. However will be allowed to take all the benefit's of attending society's conferences as a member of SNMI and also a Student member.
